



## Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office

### Press Release

On 12/20/21 at 11:00 a.m., the Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to 250<sup>th</sup> Street and 475<sup>th</sup> Ave, also known as the Baltic Corner, for a two-vehicle crash. A 27-year-old male was located pinned underneath a Freightliner bucket truck.

The investigation determined a 2020 Chevy pickup, driven by a 26-year-old male, with a 28-year-old passenger was southbound on 475<sup>th</sup> Avenue, when it collided with a 2019 Freightliner bucket truck, driven by a 27-year-old male, that was westbound on 250<sup>th</sup> Street. The Freightliner rolled onto its side, which pinned the driver. Emergency personnel worked for approximately 45 minutes until the driver was extricated. He was airlifted to Sanford and is in serious, but stable condition. Both occupants of the pickup received minor injuries. Traffic traveling east and west is controlled by a stop sign at this intersection. The driver of the Freightliner was cited for a stop sign violation.

The Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office was assisted by: South Dakota Highway Patrol, Minnehaha County Emergency Management, South Dakota DOT, Dell Rapids Fire Department, Baltic Fire Department, Dell Rapids Ambulance, and Sanford AirMed.
